Enrollment Policy- Since PCT does not turn away children, we limit enrollment to the number of roles available in a given production. Legend of Sleepy Hollow has 30 roles. We will accept the first thirty students who:

- 1- Have completed all paperwork
- 2- Have made full payment(cost \$180.00)
- 3- Have no more than three conflicts with rehearsal dates (see Conflict Policy)

Audition Information- To audition please fill out the attached enrollment form and mail it along with full payment to us. Once we receive you information you will be called to set up an appointment time. Every child who auditions will get a part. Your audition time will be a ten-minute block on Monday August 20th or Wednesday August 22nd from 4:00-6:30pm. For the audition itself, please have your child prepare up to a one minute monologue, poem, or story to perform for the director and assistant director. Please also have your child dressed to move as there will be a brief movement section of the audition.

Crew- Another way to be a part of any production at PCT is to be a member of our running crew. During the rehearsals crew members help to build and paint the scenery, hang and adjust stage lights, and learn how to set up and take down a sound system. During the actual shows crew members are needed to run the lighting and sound systems, change the scenery, and assist with costume changes. This is great way to be a part of a production even if your child has major stage fright. Crew members are called to all Monday and Wednesday rehearsals as well as tech week and production dates. You can enroll your child in Crew by filling out the enrollment form and using the provided space to note that you are enrolling in Crew.

Callbacks and Casting- After each child has auditioned we hold callbacks, which is a mix between a first rehearsal and a second audition. Students will meet their teammates play a few teambuilding games and read excerpts from the script. Callbacks are on Friday, August 24th from 4:30-6:30pm. Every cast member student must attend. After Callbacks the production team will make casting decisions and put the full cast list up on our website no later than Saturday August 25th at noon.

Parent Meeting- From 6:30-7:00pm Monday August 27th, we will have our parent meeting. At the meeting you will meet the production team, ask any questions you may have, and sign up for volunteer committees (not a requirement). Please plan to attend even

if you have already done a show with us in the past.

Rehearsals- Our rehearsals are generally Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays from 4:30-6:30. Our first rehearsal is Monday August 27th. Our final rehearsal before tech week is October 12th from 4:30-6:30. We have rehearsals on the following dates-

Mondays- 8/27, 9/10, 9/17, 9/24, 10/1, 10/8

Wednesdays-8/29, 9/5, 9/12, 9/19, 9/26, 10/3, 10/10

Fridays- 8/31, 9/7, 9/21, 9/28, 10/5, 10/12

Conflict Policy- We prefer that you have no conflicts with our regular rehearsal schedule. We can accept students with up to three conflicts with the above dates. We cannot accept conflicts with Tech Week or Production Dates. Use the space provided on the enrollment form to notify us of any conflicts in advance.
